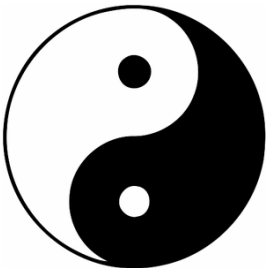


DONNIE EDWARDS
